Hurricane Harvey is gone but many areas are still struggling with its aftermath. Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) has provided a \$100,000.00 grant to the four Districts along the Texas Coast and the Texas Lions Foundation has also provided more than \$40,000.00 in grants. 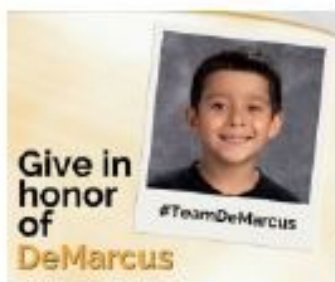
Second Cabinet Meeting
