Speaking of good fortune and good luck, the enthusiasm for the Pedia-Vision Spot program is picking up steam. All of the proceeds for this year's STRIDE FOR SIGHT is going for the purchase of these fancy gizmo's.

What exactly is a Pedia-Vision Spot system? Well, it's a handheld eye examination system that is meant for young children - as young as 6 months old! Can you imagine trying to test a child at age 6 months or 7 months? It would be impossible! And yet so many eye problems that could be debilitating in later years can now be caught in the earliest months. The Pedia-Vision test is geared to work with day-care centers, pre-k kids, where there is no alternative to test.

You see, the State of Texas mandates that children in kindergarten have their initial eye test...our program can test these children years before that.

So there are three major steps in

establishing such a program:

1. Raise the funds to purchase these systems (about \$7,000 each)...we can share the systems with our fellow clubs.
2. Educate, train and get Lion testers certified by the State of Texas to do the exams.
3. Coordinate with fellow Lions Clubs to participate in this eye testing effort.

Eyes can be saved! Eye-sights can be improved! Lives can be enhanced!

it's a known fact that children cannot learn very well, if they cannot see very well. Catching the problems from the start can not only improve a child's vision, but can impact their very lives!




