Greetings, fellow Lions!

Recently I was reading an address by Albert Mensah of Seattle, Washington, and he was recounting his days when he first came to America from his native Ghana.

He arrived in 1999 from; a tiny village in West Africa. He barely knew the language, he stood out from the crowd with his color, his dress, his mannerisms and his accent. He said, "What's the first thing that comes to mind when you hear the word 'immigrant?' Poor? Pitiful? Persecuted? Maybe all of those words.

"Well, these words may fit the average idea of immigrants - but the average isn't always reality.

"Did you know that 80 percent of all the millionaires in this country are immigrants? Yes! Four out of five millionaires in America are first-generation Americans. Do you know why? Because immigrants are willing to do all the jobs that people born in this country will not do."

Albert went on to say that he calls it the "classified theory." It sounds pretty confidential, but it's not. It's really this simple. Do you know what's in the classified section of the newspaper? Jobs, jobs, jobs - and more jobs. Every day you can pick up the classified section of a big-city newspaper and find 200 to 500 jobs. On Sunday, there are 20,000 jobs. These jobs pay anything

from minimum wage to hundreds of thousands of dollars per year.

Most of us just sit at home and wonder why we don't have the right job, but the immigrant comes into America with an **attitude of gratitude**. He's thinking, "Wow, I have a great opportunity here!"
