### From 1<sup>st</sup> VDG John Lee



Hard to believe but it is time to begin getting ready for your club elections. We also have the District 2A2 elections in April at the District Convention in Kerrville and the multidistrict 2 elections in May in College station.

Your Club elections need to be done by the 15<sup>th</sup> of April and **the PU101 (new officer form)** submitted to the District Governors office by the end of April so the new District Directory can be completed and also reported to International Lions via your MYLCI.

#### Delegates for District Elections

##### “ARTICLE VII DISTRICT/STATE CONVENTION

Section 5. CLUB REPRESENTATION: Each Chartered Club in good

standing in Lions

International and the District shall be represented by one or more delegates at the Annual District Convention and shall be entitled in each such Convention to one voting delegate and one alternate for each ten members, or major fraction thereof, of said Club as shown by the records of the International Office on the first day of the month last preceding that month during which the Convention is held. The major fraction referred to in this Section shall be five (5) or more members.

Each certified delegate present in person may cast one vote only for each office to be filled and one vote only on each issue to be voted on by the members of said Convention. Unless otherwise specified herein, the affirmative vote of a majority of delegates voting on any question shall be the act of the Convention.

Each Past District Governor of this District that is a member in good standing of a Club in good standing shall be entitled to be a voting delegate. Such right will not be counted as part of the number of delegates that a Club is allowed”.

What we would ask is that the President or Secretary of each Club forward their Certified list of Delegates and Alternates to the Credentials Chair by email or regular mail to be received no later than April 1, 2015. We will send out a Flash Bulletin on or about March 3 which will have the official number of delegates for each Club that will, by then, have come to the District Governor from LCI.

The number of eligible delegates would be based on the MyLCI roster listing at March 1, 2015. All

Clubs must have been chartered at least one year prior to the date of the Convention to have eligible delegates, however, if they have not they still are authorized one delegate vote. **REMEMBER THAT ALL CLUBS MUST BE IN GOOD STANDING (PAID ALL DUES OWED TO LCI AND THE DISTRICT)** to be eligible to have their delegates cast votes in the election.

In the event that we do not receive a certified list from the President or Secretary prior to the Convention, we will have a listing by Clubs at the Credentials Table at the Convention of allowed numbers for each Club and the Club President or Secretary can tell us, then, who their certified delegates are.

### **Delegates for State Elections**

Each chartered Lions Club in Multiple District 2 which is in good standing with the International Association of Lions Clubs, Multiple District 2, and their respective subdistrict, shall be entitled in each annual convention of Multiple District 2 to one (1) delegate and one (1) alternate for each ten (10) members who have been enrolled for at least one year and a day in the club or major fraction thereof of said club as shown by the records of the International Association of Lions Clubs on the first day of the month last preceding that month during which the convention is held. The major fraction referred to shall be five (5) or more members.

Delegate forms will be mailed out by LCI when they received your convention registration.

**OFFICIAL STATE CONVENTION CALL**

THE ANNUAL STATE CONVENTION OF MULTIPLE DISTRICT TWO (TEXAS) SHALL BE CONVENED AT THE TIMES AND PLACES OF THE SIXTEEN DISTRICT CONVENTIONS OF MULTIPLE DISTRICT TWO FOR THE PURPOSE ONLY OF VOTING ON ANY AND ALL ITEMS APPROVED FOR THE MULTIPLE DISTRICT TWO (TEXAS) BALLOT. THE STATE CONVENTION WILL THEN BE RECESSED TO BE RECONVENED ON THE **22nd** DAY OF **MAY** AT **COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS**.

EACH CHARTERED CLUB IN THE STATE IN GOOD STANDING WITH LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL, STATE, AND DISTRICT DUES PAID TO DATE, ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT THEY ARE ENTITLED TO ONE (1) VOTING DELEGATE AND ONE (1) ALTERNATE FOR EACH TEN (10) MEMBERS OF SAID CLUB, OR MAJOR FRACTION THEREOF, AS SHOWN BY THE RECORDS OF LIONS INTERNATIONAL ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH LAST PRECEDING THAT MONTH DURING WHICH THE CONVENTION IS HELD. THE MAJOR FRACTION REFERRED TO SHALL BE FIVE (5) OR MORE MEMBERS. ONLY REGISTERED DELEGATES WITH CERTIFIED CREDENTIALS, PRESENT IN PERSON AT ANY MEETING OF THE CONVENTION, SHALL BE ENTITLED TO VOTE. ELIGIBLE DELEGATES ARE MEMBERS WHO HAVE BEEN ENROLLED FOR AT LEAST ONE (1) YEAR AND A DAY IN THE CLUB AS SHOWN BY THE RECORDS OF THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE AS COUNTED FOR PURPOSES OF CALCULATING DELEGATE ENTITLEMENT. EACH SUCH DELEGATE MAY CAST ONLY ONE (1) VOTE ON EACH QUESTION.

THE PHRASE "MEMBERS" WHO HAVE BEEN ENROLLED FOR AT LEAST ONE (1) YEAR AND A DAY IN THE CLUB IS INTERPRETED TO MEAN THE FOLLOWING:

A TRANSFEREE SHALL BE COUNTED AS A MEMBER FOR THE PURPOSE OF CALCULATING THE DELEGATE ENTITLEMENT OF THE CLUB IF THE TRANSFEREE HAS BEEN A MEMBER OR RECEIVED TRANSFER FOR AT LEAST ONE (1) YEAR AND ONE (1) DAY.

A REINSTATED MEMBER SHALL BE COUNTED AS A MEMBER FOR THE PURPOSE OF CALCULATING THE CLUBS DELEGATE ENTITLEMENT PROVIDED THAT THE REINSTATED MEMBER HAS BEEN A MEMBER FOR AN AGGREGATE PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAT ONE (1) YEAR AND ONE (1) DAY.

A NEWLY CHARTERED CLUB WILL BE ENTITLED TO ONE (1) DELEGATE AND ONE (1) ALTERNATE DELEGATE UNTIL IT HAS BEEN CHARTERED FOR ONE (1) YEAR AND ONE (1) DAY. THEREAFTER, THE DELEGATE QUOTA WILL BE BASED ON THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS ENROLLED IN THE CLUB FOR ONE (1) YEAR AND ONE (1) DAY.

CLUBS BEING RELEASED FROM STATUS QUO WILL HAVE THEIR DELEGATE QUOTA BASED ON THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS ENROLLED IN THE CLUB FOR ONE (1) YEAR AND ONE (1) DAY AT THE TIME OF BEING RELEASED FROM STATUS QUO. HOWEVER, A CLUB BEING RELEASED FROM STATUS QUO WILL BE ENTITLED TO A MINIMUM OF ONE (1) DELEGATE, AND ONE (1) ALTERNATE DELEGATE.

Because of Lion John's interests and activities in Lionism, he is now a Century Club Member, Life Member and Jack Welch Fellow of the Texas Lions Camp, and



**Lions District 2-A2 Hearing Board**  
**Proposed constitutional Amendments.**

Article III- Purpose and Objectives

Section 1: The purpose of the BOARD, as a Non-profit Organization providing charitable services, shall be to provide, when and where possible, free hearing and vision screenings during regular school hours for children in District 2-A2: and to provide access to hearing test and hearing aids for adult individuals in financial need within the District.

**Proposed Change to:**

***Article III – Purpose and Objectives***

***Section 1: The purpose of the BOARD, as a non- profit organization providing a charitable service, when and where possible, shall arrange for hearing test's and hearing aids for adults and children in financial need in District 2-A2.***

Section 2: The Objectives of the **BOARD** shall be:

E: To work with the Texas Department of Health representative to establish training sessions for individuals interested in becoming hearing and vision certified.

F: To make audiometers available to Lions Clubs in District 2-A2 for the purpose of providing hearing screenings in local communities. All operators of the audiometers must be currently hearing certified by the State of Texas. Clubs must arrange for checking out and returning the equipment and guarantee its safety while not in the **BOARD'S** possession. All audiometers must be under lock when left in a car or building to satisfy insurance requirements.

***[Proposed Change is to completely remove E and F of section 2 of Article III.]***

# Hearing Board Constitution Amendments:

## Article IV – Membership

### Section 1: Composition

***Add: D. Membership in the Hearing BOARD is a privilege with that said we welcome those who wish to serve on a single Board.***

## Article IV

### Section 3. Voting

- C. A simple majority will decide issues on normal operating procedures and expenditures of more than one hundred dollars (100.00) but Less than two hundred fifty dollars (250.00).
- D. A two thirds (2/3<sup>rd</sup>) majority will be required on matter of policy, election of officers and expenditures of two hundred fifty dollars(250.00) or more.

***Proposed Change: Section 3. voting***

***C. and D. change the existing amount of two hundred fifty dollars (250.00)***

***Change to five hundred dollars (500.00).***

## ARTICLE V - OFFICERS

Section 3: The Chairman is responsible for providing hearing application to clients, and the authorization to dispense hearing aids. The Vice Chairman is responsible for hearing and vision screenings of school children. The Duties of the Secretary are to take the minutes of each meeting and provide copies to all members of the Board. The duties of the Treasurer are to provide a financial statement at each meeting for all Board members and to make payments for expenditures in accordance with Board policy.

***Proposed Change:***

***Section 3: (Sentence 2) The Responsibilities of Vice Chairman is to oversee all BOARD functions during the absence of the Chairman, and assisting in the duties of our hearing aid program.***

***Section 4: Completely remove as we will no longer own audiometers.***

ARTICLE VI – MEETINGS

Section 1: Regular Meetings of the **BOARD** shall be scheduled to be held in conjunction with the District Cabinet meetings, Mid Winter Conference, and District 2-A2 Convention.

**SECTION 3: The BOARD shall meet as often as District 2-A2 has meetings, Conferences, Conventions, and at other times, locations as necessary to conduct business.**

**ARTICLE VII – FISCAL MANAGEMENT**

**SECTION B: EXPENDURES – Match the amount change previously in ARTICLE IV, SECTION 3 (C & D).**

ARTICLE VIII – DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution of this **BOARD**, any monies remaining in the Treasury of the **BOARD** shall revert to District 2-A2. In turn, the District may retain the funds in a designated account for a period not to exceed three (3) years. If at that time, another hearing board or similar origination is not formed, the funds must be designated for the use of another charitable origination registered under the International Revenue Code Regulation 501 C (3), preferably within District 2-A2.

**Proposed change: (Sentence 3)**

**If in that time, another Hearing Board or similar organization is not formed, the funds must be divided amongst all boards, and entities of Lions District 2-A2.**

**If approved by the lions of District 2-A2 these changes will become effective at the completion of the District 2-A2 convention April 12, 2015.**

Just a note about the Amendments to the Hearing Board Constitution.

At the Mid Winter conference it was reported that the hearing Board will no longer own Audiometers. This was a unanimous decision of the Board directly related to the ratio of units being used verses certified screeners in our District.

Lions District 2-A 2 Clubs who have units have been notified that if they wish to own a unit they will be first in line to receive one provided they have submitted written request, and having returned their unit back to the hearing board chair. Other clubs wishing to attain one for ownership will be on a first come first serve basis by date of written request as long as they are available.

With that the amendments are related to this, and a couple of housekeeping items as well.
