

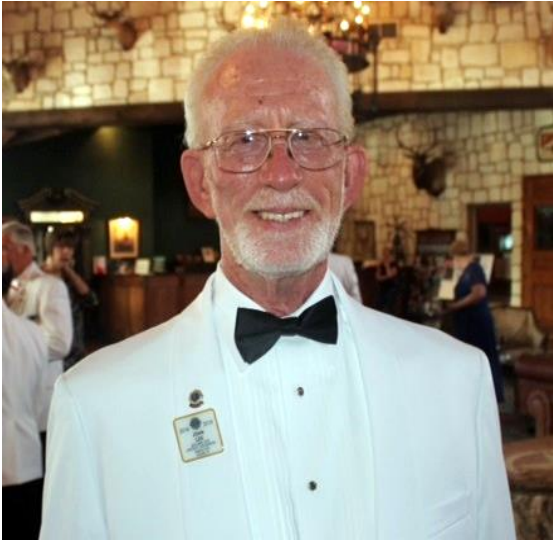

CLUB OFFICER TRAINING FOR 2017-2018

In two short months, we will begin another Lions year. Each year the District provides Club Officer training classes for the Club Presidents, Secretaries, Treasurers and Zone Chairs but these sessions usually have a very low attendance.

In my visits to different clubs over the past two years, I have noticed too often that many Club officers really don't understand their job duties. It's not a hard job but there are certain tasks that need to be performed. Too often, a newly elected Secretary or Treasurer will be told "there's nothing to it" or "we'll show you how". What seems to happen reminds me of a car sales advertisement on TV several years back entitled the "disappearing salesman". Once he made the sale, you no longer saw him.

This coming year the District will be placing more emphasis on the Club Officer training by providing two training classes in the San Antonio metroplex and three classes in different towns in the rural areas of the District. These classes will be spread over a three month period of June, July and August.

Needs change. For Presidents, each year there is a new District Governor. What are the new Governor's goals and what tools can the President use to lead their Club? The Secretary is a key officer in a Club. He/she does all of the recording of minutes, correspondence, and most importantly reporting the Club's membership and activities on International's MyLCI website. The Treasurer is not only entrusted with the financial transactions of the Club but must be well versed in the requirements of the IRS and State Sales Tax issues. Where can you learn about these issues? By attending a Club Officer Training class coming near you. Well, hopefully no more than an hour's drive from you.

Classes are about two hours long and the Presidents, Secretaries and Treasurers and Zone Chairs are divided up into separate classes. If your office happens to be a combined Secretary/Treasurer, we will provide you with the training materials for both.

If you are a newly elected officer, or even in your second or third year of an office, you need to attend one of the training classes. The first class will be held in Comfort at the Comfort Public Library on June 3rd (Saturday) from 10:00 a.m. until noon. The second class will be at the Universal City Library on June 12th (Monday) in the evening. Stay tuned for further details.

As classes are scheduled they will be placed on the District's website calendar and we will also send out NEWS FLASH bulletins with the latest information. If you have not signed up for the District website for the NEWS FLASH bulletins, do so now by going to the District website at district2a2.org.

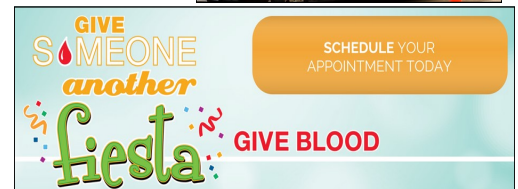

24th ANNUAL HARRY WICKERSHAM GOLF TOURNAMENT

1. Scramble Format.
2. All men must play from the blue tees on the Par 3's.
Men 65 & over may play from white tees on other holes.
Men 80 & over and ladies may play from the red tees
3. There is a **"two putt maximum"** per hole from anywhere on the green. ***Pick Up The Ball If You Do Not Make The First Putt.***
4. **Hole in One Prize:** A new car sponsored by Crenwelge Automotive Group, Fredericksburg & Kerrville.
5. **Hole Prizes:** (These are in addition to the Hole in One Prizes.)
YOU MUST PLAY THE SHOT TO WIN THE PRIZE!!!
The longest drive must be in the fairway to win.
The straightest drive is the closest to the line, not the longest. If the distance from the line is the same for more than one drive, then the longest drive is the winner.
6. A Scorecard Playoff will determine the winner for all ties.

ENTRY FEE INCLUDES:

1. **MULLIGANS:** One Mulligan per team member per front nine and one per back nine.
2. **HOOLOGAN:** One Hooligan per team. You may move your ball up to 20' from off the green onto the green, but no closer to the hole than one club length from the edge of the green.
3. **ON THE GREEN:** Place your ball at the designated spot on the green. This is your tee shot. One stroke. Two putt maximum. Guaranteed Birdie! This will speed up play.
4. **MONSTER DRIVE:** Place your drive at the designated spot on the par five fairway. Do not hit your drive. This is your tee shot. One stroke. This will speed up play.
