_____	The vision screening shows <b>no obvious symptoms of a vision problem</b> . However, this screening is <b>not</b> a substitute for a professional eye examination. A professional eye examination is recommended at birth, six months of age, and during the preschool years when the child is 3 to 5 years of age. If there is a family history of eye problems or your child exhibits symptoms, it is advisable to have your child's eyes examined.
