- **To Encourage** service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.

Lions Code of Ethics

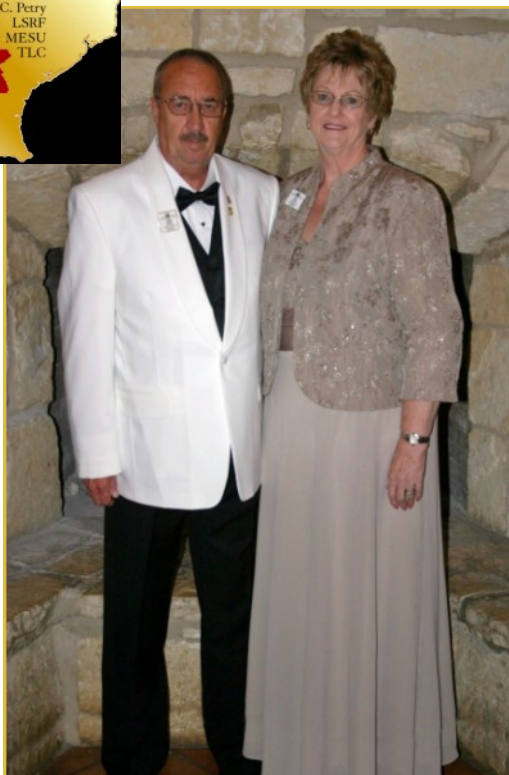
- **To Show** my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

- **To Remember** that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and true to myself.
- **Whenever** a doubt arises as to the right or ethics of my position or action towards others, to resolve such doubt against myself.
- **To Hold** friendship as an end and not a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it is given.
- **Always** to bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state, and my community, as to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act, and deed. To give them freely of my time, labor and means.
- **To Aid** others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.

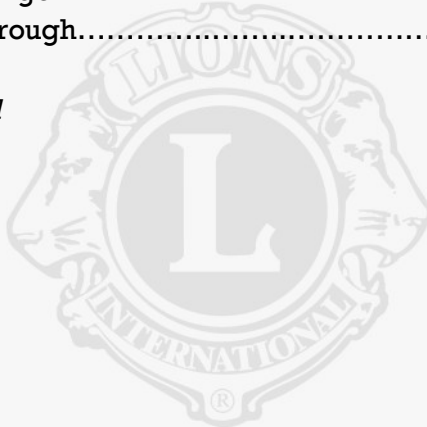

Protocol for Governors Visit

- No other program should be planned. The Governor is your speaker.
- The senior cabinet member should introduce the governor. If no cabinet member is present, the club president should make the introductions.
- It is appropriate to invite the zone chair. Spouses meetings are permitted and encouraged.
- Address the Governor by title.
- Members should rise and applaud the beginning and the end of the Governor's presentation. This is a courtesy to the office and not the person.
- Schedule the Governor's talk at the end of the meeting.
- Lions International requires the Governor to meet with the club's board of directors. Arrange for this at the end of the meeting.
- If the club has new members to induct, the Governor should be notified in advance, usually 48 hours or more.
- If the meeting is a spouse's night, notify the Governor in Advance.
- Seat the Governor at the head table, just to the right of the podium and opposite the podium from the president.

District 2-A2 Cabinet

The cabinet consists of the District Governor, 1st & 2nd Vice District Governors, Region and Zone Chairs, Cabinet Secretary, Cabinet Treasurer, and District Committee Chairs (elected or appointed).

Vice District Governor

The Vice District Governor is elected each year and normally is elected Governor the following year. The Vice District Governor serves as assistant to the Governor. He or she will head the MERLO team for their year. He or she will be the District Chair for the **Lion Marion Jones Stride for Sight** committee.

Second Vice District Governor

The 2nd Vice District Governor is elected each year and normally is elected 1st Vice District Governor the

following year. The 2nd Vice District serves as assistant to the Governor; works with the District Retention committee; serves on the MERLO team, and is the co-chair for the Stride for Sight committee.

Region Chairs

Assist the MERLO team and clubs in their region. Visit clubs, induct members, coordinate region meetings and attends all district meetings. They are aware of activities of all clubs in their region through the Zone Chairs. Appraise the Governor of activities or need of assistance and help in the Governor's Leadership Training Program.

Zone Chairs

Represents the "grass roots" of Lionism. They coordinate the clubs in their zone and remain constantly aware of membership, attendance, dues payments, programs, funding, and/or the need for assistance in each. They evaluate the strengths and weakness of the clubs for the District Governor and recommend assistance where needed. They coordinate club attendance region meetings and stay in contact with the Region Chair and District Governor. They are responsible for assisting and insuring club secretaries submit required club reports on time.

Committee Chairs

Committee Chairs have the responsibility for organizing and implementing the Programs of their respective committees. They form the working corps of the District.

District Governors Advisory Committee

Shall be made up of all Past District Governors in the District. It shall assist the Zone Chair in an advisory capacity; make recommendations affecting the welfare of Lionism and the clubs in the Zone. Relay the same through the Zone Chair to the District Governor and cabinet.

Club President Excellence Award

The club shall comply with the Lions Clubs International constitution and bylaws and the policies of the Board of Directors.

The club is in good standing to Lions Club International, the multiple district, and the district at the end of the fiscal year, June 30.

The club must show a net gain in club membership for the fiscal year. Deaths and transfers are not counted. Or the club must sponsor at least one (1) new Lions Club during the president's term of office.

The president, during his/her term, shall sponsor one new Lion into the club, and have inducted him/her during the fiscal year.

The club has made a contribution to LCIF.

The club must have conducted at least one major service activity, which shall have been reported on the Activities Report. Organization of a Leo Club can be regarded a major service activity.

The Officer Reporting Forms (MMR and PU-101) must have been submitted to International by May 31.

The president must have attended all of the following: at least two zone meetings, club officer orientation training, and district, multiple district or international convention during his/her term in office.

In order to qualify for the award, the club president must certify that all new members have been properly inducted and indoctrinated and involved by assignment to a working activity or service committee

In order to be eligible for the Club Presidents Excellence Award, the president must have been recommended by the Zone or Region Chairperson to the District Governor. The District Governor must have certified that the president met all the above requirements. Certification must be mailed to the International office within 30 days after the close of International Convention.

The Club President must certify that all new members have been properly inducted and have participated in a service activity.

100% CLUB SECRETARY

The application for this award should be completed by the Club Secretary and approved by the proper District Officers.

1. Monthly Membership Reports (MMR's) mailed to the District Governor and post marked no later than the third (3rd) of the month. This requirement begins with the August MMR Report. (Example: August MMR Report must be postmarked prior to September 4.)
2. Must have sponsored one (1) new member during the year or the club must meet the District Governor's membership goal.
3. All accounts paid when due to Lions International and District and reported on MMR Report for the month in which it was paid.
4. Attend all three (3) Zone Meetings. Authorized substitute may attend one (1) Zone Meeting in your place.
5. Attend all Cabinet Meetings, Mid-Winter Conference, and the District Convention. An authorized substitute may attend one (1) in your place.
6. File your Club IRS-990 form on or before October 31, and report same on the October MMR Report.
7. Complete and mail PU-101 forms to International and District prior to April 15th.
8. Be recommended for the award by your Club President and your Zone Chairman by letter to the Cabinet Secretary.

History of Lions Clubs International

The first meeting convened with 36 delegates and eight alternates. There were 12 original clubs from Texas that joined lionism when it was officially formed. These were Abilene, Austin, Beaumont, Dallas, Ft. Worth, Houston, Paris, Port Arthur, San Antonio, Temple, Waco and Wichita Falls. These clubs are known as Founder Clubs.

October 8,1917, Texas became District 4. In 1921 District 4 became District 2 as a result of the International Convention in Oakland. California.

At the 1930 Convention held in Austin, Texas District 2 was divided into 5 District: 2T, 2E, 2X, 2A and 2 S. After the 1942 Convention, District 2S was divided into three Districts: 2-S1,2-S2 and 2-S3. This increased the number of Districts in Texas to seven.

At the Convention held in 1958, District 2T was divided into three Districts: 2-T1,2-T2,2-T3. This increased the number of Districts in Texas to nine.

At the Convention in 1959, Texas was divided into the following fifteen districts: 2-T1,2-T2,2-T3,2-E1,2-E2,2-X1,2-X2,2-X3,2-A1,2-A1,2-A3,2-A3,2-S1,2-S2,2-S3 and 2-S4. At the 1988 Convention, Texas was divided into sixteen Districts: adding 2-S5. There are still sixteen Districts in Texas as of 2010.

Melvin Jones was born on January 13, 1879 in Fort Thomas, Arizona, the son of a United States Army Captain who commanded a troop of scouts. Later, his father was transferred and the family moved east. As a young man, Jones made his home in Chicago, Illinois, became associated with an insurance firm and in 1913 formed his own agency.

He soon joined the Business Circle, a businessmen's luncheon group, and was shortly elected secretary. This group was one of many at that time devoted

solely to promoting the financial interests of their membership. Because of their limited appeal they were destined to disappear. Melvin Jones, however, had other plans? "What if these men", he asked, "who are successful because of their drive, intelligence and ambition, were to put their talents to work improving their communities?" Thus, at his invitation, delegates from men's clubs met in Chicago to lay the groundwork for such an organization and on June 7, 1917, Lions Clubs International was born. It was stipulated that clubs were not to be social in nature nor were members permitted to promote their own business interest.

Jones eventually abandoned his insurance agency to devote himself full time to Lions at International Headquarters in

Chicago. It was under his dynamic leadership that Lions Clubs Earned the prestige necessary to attract civic-minded members.

The association's founder was also recognized as a leader outside the association. One of his greatest honors was in 1945 when he represented Lions Clubs International as a consultant in San Francisco, California, at the organization of the United Nations.

Melvin Jones, the man whose personal code "You can't get very far until you start doing something for somebody else" became a guiding principle for public-spirited people the world over, died June 1, 1961 at 82 years of age.

Bordering this is a circular gold area with two lion profiles at either side facing away from the center. The word, "LIONS" appears at the top, and "International" at the bottom. Symbolically the lions face both the past and the future-proud of the past and confident of the future.

Lions Clubs International recognizes the importance of protecting the private information of our members. LCI collects personal information about Lions Club members and Leo Club members to facilitate communications with and between our members. This information is to be used solely to further its Purposes including that “to unite the clubs in bonds of friendship good fellowship and mutual understanding” and to conduct its necessary operational activities including:

- Dues and other billings
- Distribution of The Lion magazine and membership/officer information and updates
- Compilation of membership profiles and trends to support membership growth, extension and retention programs
- Convention and meeting planning

- Contact information for Lion/Leo leaders, including past and present International Officers, Directors, and Board Appointees, Multiple District Council Chairpersons and Council of Governors, District and Vice District Governors, and Club Officers
- Furtherance of Public Relations activities and Cooperative Alliances
- Support of Lions Clubs International Foundation and other adopted service programs
- Special advertising, non-dues revenue programs or other purposes in accordance with the Purposes and Objects as determined by the International Board of Directors
- Disclosure of information as required by law or that is pertinent to judicial or governmental investigations

Lions Clubs International protects personal information by using password-protected areas and by restricting access to such information. It is important that you protect your password.

Any payment information collected is protected by software during transmission, which encrypts all of your personal information so that it can be safeguarded over Internet channels. We reveal only a limited part of your credit card number when confirming an order.

The official directory is not available on the Internet without a password, but a club locator with club officer contact information is available. The club locator is designed so that it cannot be used as a commercial mailing list and Lions/Leo Club members should ensure it is not used for that purpose.

Privacy Recommendations for Lions/ Leo Clubs, Districts, Multiple Districts and Foundations

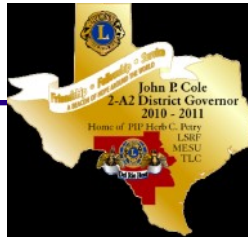
Your Lions/Leo Club, District, Multiple District and/or Foundation should consider your privacy practices and follow similar guidelines when using the personal information of members, donors, recipients of your humanitarian assistance, or that of other individuals obtained in the course of conducting your activities.

You should consider obtaining written permission before disclosing any personal information including names, addresses, email addresses, telephone num-

bers, medical information, financial information, etc. You should also be cautious when posting any personal information on the Internet or sharing email addresses with third parties.

Please be aware that LOCAL LAWS MAY GOVERN THIS ISSUE and these laws vary widely from country to country, so you should seek advice from a local expert for more information before any personal information is used.

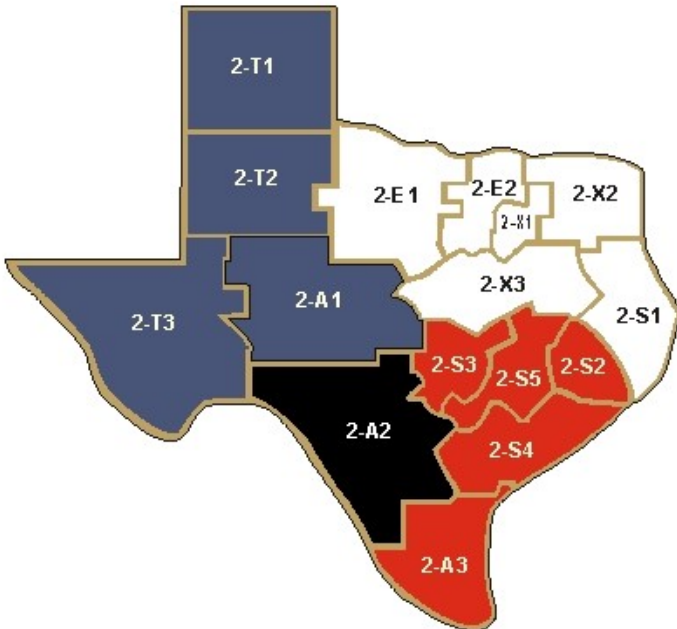
