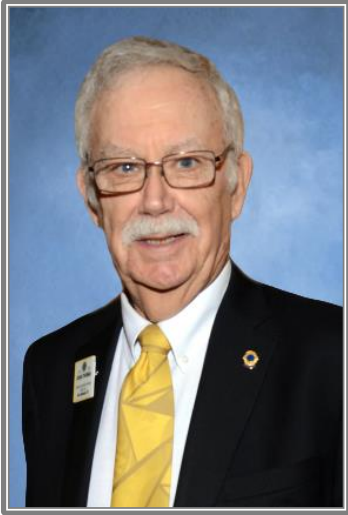

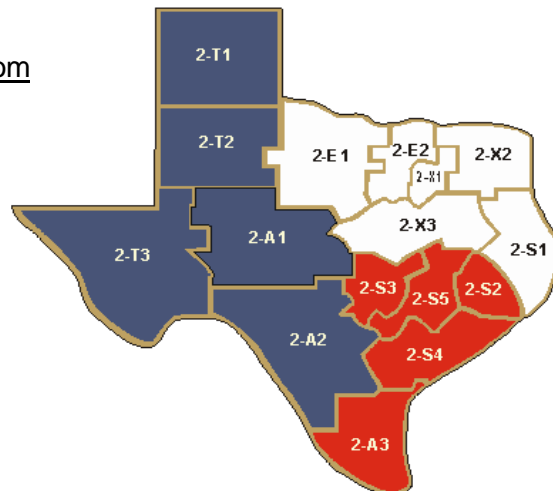

History of the International Association of Lions Clubs

Officially formed October, 1917

First President:	W.P. Woods (Indiana)
Vice-President:	L.H. Lewis, (Dallas, Texas)
Secretary/Treasurer:	Melvin Jones (Chicago, Illinois)
One-Year Director:	C.H. Kirk (Houston, Texas)

First meeting convened with 36 delegates and eight alternates. There were 12 original clubs from Texas that joined Lionism when it was officially formed. These were Abilene, Austin, Beaumont, Dallas, Ft. Worth, Houston, Paris, Port Arthur, San Antonio, Temple, Waco, and Wichita Falls. These clubs are known as Founder Clubs.

In October 8, 1917, Texas became District 4.

In 1921 District 4 became District 2 as a result of the International Convention in Oakland, California.

At the 1930 Convention held in Austin, Texas District 2 was divided into 5 Districts. (2T, 2E, 2X, 2A, & 2S).

After the 1942 Convention, District 2S was divided into three Districts: 2-S1, 2-S2, and 2-S3. This increased the number of Districts in Texas to seven.

At the Convention held in 1958, District 2T was divided into three Districts: 2-T1, 2-T2, and 2-T3. This increased the number of districts in Texas to nine.

At the Convention in 1959, Texas was divided into fifteen Districts: 2-T1, 2-T2, 2-T3, 2-E1, 2-E2, 2-X1, 2-X2, 2-X3, 2-A1, 2-A2, 2-A3, 2-S1, 2-S2, 2-S3, and 2-S4.

At the Convention in 1988, Texas was divided into sixteen Districts: adding District 2-S5. There are still sixteen Districts in Texas as of 2022-2023.

Throughout the World, Lions are recognized by the emblem they wear on their lapels. It consists of a gold letter “L” on a circular blue field. The golden band around the blue field represents unity of service by all Lions meeting the needs of those less fortunate in each community being served. Bordering this circular gold area, there are two Lion profiles at either side facing away from the center. Symbolically, the Lions face both the past and the future – proud of the past and confident of the future.

The word “LIONS” appears at the top and stands for: Liberty Intelligence Our Nations Safety (It is also said to represent) Loving Individuals Offering Needed Service. The word “International” appears at the bottom reinforcing the fact that we are the largest world-wide association in scope and service.

Lions Clubs International Objectives

TO ORGANIZE, *charter and supervise service clubs to be known as Lions clubs.*

TO COORDINATE *the activities and standardize the administration of Lions clubs.*

TO CREATE *and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.*

TO PROMOTE *the principles of good government and good citizenship.*

TO TAKE *an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community.*

TO UNITE *the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.*

TO PROVIDE *a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by club members.*

TO ENCOURAGE *service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.*

Lions Motto – We Serve

In 1954, the Lions Clubs International Board of Directors announced an International Motto Contest and invited suggestions from all 522,000 worldwide members. The motto had to be enduring, international in character, easily translatable and no more than five words. When it was over, 11 of the 6,000 Lion contestants had submitted identical entries. Canadian Lion D. A. Stevenson from Fonthill, Ontario, was declared the winner since his submission had the earliest postmark. His motto contained two simple words: “We Serve.”

Lions serve. It’s that simple, and it has been since we first began in 1917. Our clubs are places where individuals join together to give their valuable time and effort to improving their communities, and the world.

Lions Clubs International protects personal information by using password-protected areas and by restricting access to such information. It is important that you protect your password.

Any payment information collected is protected by software during transmission, which encrypts all of your personal information so that it can be safeguarded over Internet channels. We reveal only a limited part of your credit card number when confirming an order. The official directory is not available on the Internet without a password, but a club locator with club officer contact information is available. The club locator is designed so that it cannot be used as a commercial mailing list and Lions Club members should ensure it is not used for that purpose.

Privacy Recommendations for Lions Clubs, Districts, Multiple Districts and Foundations

Your Lions Club, District, Multiple District and/or Foundation should consider your privacy practices and follow similar guidelines when using the personal information of members, donors, recipients of your humanitarian assistance, or that of other individuals obtained in the course of conducting your activities. You should consider obtaining written permission before disclosing any personal information including names, addresses, email addresses, telephone numbers, medical information, financial information, etc. You should also be cautious when posting any personal information on the Internet or sharing email addresses with third parties. Please be aware that LOCAL LAWS MAY GOVERN THIS ISSUE and these laws vary widely from country to country, so you should seek advice from a local expert for more information before any personal information is used.
