WHEREAS, Lion Mary Ann entered into Lionism in November 2008 as a member of the La Vernia Lions Club of La Vernia, Texas, and


WHEREAS, Lion Mary Ann has served our Club as Club Treasurer and has earned the distinction of being named Lion of the Year, and
